Another online project is 365project.org. The idea here is to get you take more photos. When you join, you are supposed to take photos every day and post one on the website. Like Flickr, you can interact with photographers around the world, but without the specialized groups. 365 project also has free and paid plans.

Some of the most fun we have had with photography projects has been stuff we have dreamed up ourselves. For example, Linda took photos of a lemon placed in all sorts of odd places and put together a slide show. I did the same thing with a rubber snake and created a goofy script to match the photos.
