Obituary and newspaper article described military service. He received the Distinguished Flying Cross and Distinguished Flying Medal from King George VI at Buckingham Palace for service in the RAF and RCAF in World War II. His rank was Flight Lieutenant. He served as a wireless Air gunner with the Bomber Command Squadron. He trained in Picton, Montreal and St. John before going to England. Charter Life Member of the Brantford Air Force Club he helped found in 1946. Member of the Wartime Aircrew Association and Dunsdon Legion.

Lifelong member of Holy Trinity Anglican Church in Brantford and served as Treasure and People's Warden. Member of Brant Masonic Lodge #45, serving as Treasurer for 20 years.
